Livelihood System Dynamics

- Health Outcomes, Poverty Processes and Livelihood Strategies
- From top down, managerial, expert driven welfare approaches to participatory,selfempowering ,asset- based approaches
- Health as central component of human capital :capacity to transform other assets into income,food and other necessities

Livelihood System Dynamics cont'd

- Vulnerability context: Global, country, provincial, town/village contexts as nested hierarchy (trade, tourism, BSE,AIDS,SARS.
- Political,social,economic, cultural and environmental
- Poor as agents with strengths (as well) not passive recipients with only needs
- Power dynamics : zero to positive sum

Health in Assets Management

- Recognition of assets base including health
- Manage them sustainably rather just use them
- Build on successful coping and adaptive strategies
- Move from projects to health sector to beyond sectors : cross-sectoral (livelihoods)
- Cross-sectoral policies, macro-micro linkages, public –private partnerships, gender issues, women's networks, children and youth participation
